## 2017 Street Project Notice

### Curb Replacement

The City will be installing new concrete curb in the areas where previously removed beginning the week of Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. For those residents impacted by curb replacement within your driveway, please park vehicles in the street prior to Monday, 8:00 AM. Additionally, please continue to park in the street for 7 days after installation to allow the concrete to cure. The City will allow residents to park adjacent to their homes regardless of the “No Parking” signage during this period of curb work. Please do not park your vehicles in areas where curb has been removed, limiting access to install the new curb.

The schedule above is weather dependant. The schedule will be shifted back given poor weather conditions. The City will send additional notices as work commences. Future work will consist of street patching, pavement rehabilitation and paving. Please note, some residents are receiving these notices as it relates to construction traffic and accessing your street.
