



2021 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

August 2, 2021

Temporary Mailbox Cluster:

While the contractor conducts watermain replacement in the project area, portions of **Rice Creek Terrace** and **Brookview Drive** mail service will be temporarily moved to a mailbox cluster on the corner of Rice Creek Terrace and Brookview Drive (on Brookview). The contractor will coordinate this temporary change and reinstatement of mail delivery to your regular mailbox with the Postal Service. The City will provide an additional notice upon regular mail delivery to your property.

Watermain Replacement:

As a reminder, the contractor will continue watermain replacement on the *Rice Creek Terrace* section between 68th Avenue and Madison Street today and intends to start replacement for the Rice Creek Terrace section between Oakley Street and Brookview Drive this week. While the watermain work is taking place there will be occurrences when the water will be shut off for a duration of 4 to 6 hours. In general, residents will receive a notice in the form of a door hanger a day before the water is shut-off.

Resident Access

Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. The City and Contractor will collaborate in minimizing the inconvenience to residents during construction. Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust and mud. Generally, it can be a disruption to the neighborhood, but we are working together toward a common goal.

Worksite Safety

Although it is tempting and interesting to watch, it is very important that residents, including children, remain out of the immediate work zone. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction workers, equipment and warning signs.
