



# 2021 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

August 6, 2021

## Watermain Replacement:

The contractor has completed the installation of the watermain on Monroe Street, Brookview Drive and both sections of Rice Creek Terrace. Water Services have been completed for Monroe Street and Brookview Drive. Homeowners will still be on temporary water until the new watermain has been tested and activated. The week of August 9<sup>th</sup>, the contractor will begin installing water services on both *Rice Creek Terrace* sections (between 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Madison Street, and between Oakley Street and Brookview Drive). There are no water shut offs planned for next week.

## Street Grading:

During the week of August 9<sup>th</sup>, the street contractor will continue following behind the utility contractor on the streets where the watermain work has been completed. The street contractor will use aggregate material generated from reclamation of the streets to grade to an elevation in preparation of the installation of concrete curb & gutter and the first lift of asphalt.

## Resident Access

Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. The City and Contractor will collaborate in minimizing the inconvenience to residents during construction. Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust and mud. Generally, it can be a disruption to the neighborhood, but we are working together toward a common goal.

## Worksite Safety

Although it is tempting and interesting to watch, it is very important that residents, including children, remain out of the immediate work zone. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction workers, equipment and warning signs.
