Construction Update

Concrete Curb & Gutter Removal:

This week, the Contractor mobilized equipment and began preparation for spot removals of concrete curb & gutter. Removals are tentatively scheduled to occur the **week of September 12th**. Driveway access will be maintained for all properties during the curb removal process, however, there may be times that vehicle access to driveways is temporarily impacted as the Contractor works in an area.

Street Parking:

As a reminder, we ask that no personal vehicles or property be parked on project area streets during working hours (7 AM-7 PM, Mon-Fri). This gives the Contractor room to work and prevents any damage to personal property. Streets adjacent to the project area can be used for temporary street parking during these times.

Resident Access

Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. The City and Contractor will collaborate in minimizing the inconvenience to residents during construction. Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust and mud. Street construction can be disruptive to the neighborhood, please be patient with the contractor and contact us if you have concerns we can help with.

Worksite Safety

Although it is tempting and interesting to watch, it is very important that residents, including children, remain out of the immediate work zone. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction workers, equipment and warning signs.
