



2021 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

September 23, 2022

Street Reclamation:

The Contractor will begin street reclamation on Tuesday **September 27th** in the project streets. Street reclamation grinds the first 6"-8" of the existing roadway into a suitable aggregate base for the new pavement. The Contractor will immediately follow the street reclamation with grading to prepare the base and provide a drivable surface. As a reminder, we ask that **no vehicles be parked on the streets during working hours from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.** This gives the contractor room to work more efficiently.

Please Note:

If curb has been removed from the front of your driveway, **please continue to park vehicles outside of the street sections, or on an adjacent street where no work is being perform.** This gives the contractor room to work and prevents any damage to personal property. Streets adjacent to the project area can be used for temporary street parking during these times. We also ask that you turn off your irrigation zones for lines near the street.

The schedule is weather dependent and may be subject to change.

Resident Access

Residents will have access to their driveways during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. The City and Contractor will collaborate in minimizing the inconvenience to residents during construction. Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust and mud. Street construction can be disruptive to the neighborhood, please be patient with the contractor and contact us if you have concerns we can help with.

Worksite Safety

Although it is tempting and interesting to watch, it is very important that residents, including children, remain out of the immediate work zone. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction workers, equipment and warning signs.

The contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. There is potential for occasional work on Saturdays upon City approval. Additionally, the project covers a large area (1.8 miles). There may be times when you will not see continuous construction activity on your street.
